

2. EXISTING CONDITIONSA. Public Schools:

There are 15 schools operated by the Public School Board, distributed throughout the city. They were all constructed between 1905 and 1930 and many are filled to capacity.

Seven of the schools have combined Auditorium and Gymnasium. There is very little gym equipment in any of the schools. The structural condition of the schools is generally good.
