

Oct. 23, 1916 The School Management Committee reported as follows:

That your School Management Committee beg to report recommending:

1. That on handing over the Benson School to the Militia, we recommend that the kindergarten room be closed and the teacher transferred to the new school. *Kitchener*

2. That the classes from Grade 1 to Grade VIII inclusive, of Benson School be transferred to Connaught.

Build

3. That the City be asked to provide cars on the same basis as last year for the transfer of the pupils from Benson to Connaught.

4. That Miss Boal be appointed to the staff of teachers at the schedule salary, appointment to date from Nov. 1st. 1916.

5. That Miss Hammel be appointed to the staff of teachers at the schedule salary, appointment to date from Nov. 1st. /16.

6. That Miss H. Burnett be appointed to the staff of teachers at the schedule salary, appointment to date from Nov. 1st to end term.

7. That E. J. Anderson be granted leave of absence to the end of the present term without salary, to take a military course at Winnipeg.

8. That Mr. Detwiler be transferred to Victoria as Principal during absence of Mr. Anderson.

Moved by Mr. Bryant and carried that the report of the School Management Committee as above written be adopted.

The Building & Grounds Committee reported recommending:

1. That storm doors be placed on the west side entrances of Benson Connaught and Wetmore Schools.

2. That the repairs to the roof of the boys' entrances at Albert School at a cost not exceeding \$25.00 be made.

3. That the cottages at Albert School be moved to the new location and that a time limit be set in order not to interfere too much with school work.

4. That the arrangement of last year, re night men, in allowing head janitor at Connaught School inside quarters and appointing night men for Victoria and Albert Schools be adopted. *Kitchener*

5. That the janitor, to be appointed for the new school, give sufficient of his time to be able to look after the furnaces during the day, and that a janitor be engaged at the minimum salary to the place of Jefferies, who shall be moved, to Washington Park. (See also, Mar. 14, May 10, Aug. 22, Oct. 10, Nov. 14, Nov. 28, Dec. 12, 1916)

6. That a platform 120' long by 12' wide be placed along the front of the new school at a cost not exceeding \$150.00. *Kitchener*

7. That screens be placed around each door to the closets of the new school. *Kitchener*

8. That Benson School be given over to the Military Authorities on the same basis as last year, the date of vacation to be arranged. The board to give possession Thursday next, the men to be properly efficient to help move the school seats, the military to have the use of the school for sleeping quarters Wednesday night.
